The Sheridan County YMCA offers a leadership program to young people ages 13-15. The LIT program is a goal that many campers strive for and our camp is proud to offer this opportunity to you.

LITs are admired and respected by the younger campers and our camp staff for their commitment in working to become better leaders and members of the camp community.

The LIT program is designed to provide the skills, knowledge and experience to effectively interact with individuals and lead groups. The Leader-in-Training program is a leadership program designed to provide individuals with the skills and knowledge to interact with others and lead groups of all ages. Personal discipline such as responsibility, patience, punctuality, thoroughness, and persistence are developed and nurtured during the summer. LITs will be able to interact with younger campers and gain valuable experience in a supportive environment.

Program Goals:

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The goal of the Sheridan County YMCA LIT program is to provide leadership training for youth. Emphasis is placed on the Y's values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility. Participation in camp activities will help teens feel confident in the knowledge, experience, and leadership skills needed to apply for a future position of camp leader or become active leaders in their community.
